BYLAW NO. 12586

A BYLAW to amend various provisions of
Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2009.**
2. Section 3 of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is amended by striking out the definition “billiard hall” and substituting the following:

“ ‘billiard hall’ means a commercial undertaking containing two or more billiard or pool tables available for the use of its patrons, but does not include a liquor licence establishment for which a liquor primary licence is required under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act, an apartment building, a hotel or a club or lodge.”
3. Sections 401.1(b), 402.1(2)(h) and 404.1(1)(h) of Schedule Number IV of the said Bylaw are each amended by striking out the words “Offices, storage” where they appear and substituting the word “Storage”.
