BYLAW NO. 12751

A BYLAW to provide a sewer parcel tax

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY SEWER PARCEL TAX BYLAW 1994, AMENDMENT BYLAW 2009.
- 2. Sections 3 and 4 of Burnaby Sewer Parcel Tax Bylaw 1994 are repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "3. Every owner of a parcel capable of being drained into a sewer or drain, whether or not the parcel is connected with or is drained into the sewer or drain, shall pay for the opportunity to use the sewer or drain an annual parcel tax of \$423.55, which amount shall be reduced to \$211.78 for twenty years including the year of construction where the present or former owner or present occupier constructed any portion of the sewerage system of the City that serves that parcel.
 - 4. The collector is hereby authorized to receive money for taxes in advance of the due date and, if paid on or before the March 15, 2010, the sewer parcel charge of
 - (a) \$423.55 shall be reduced to \$402.37, and
 - (b) \$211.78 shall be reduced to \$201.19."
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into force on the first day of January, 2010.
