BYLAW NO. 12796

A BYLAW to close and remove the dedication of a certain portion of highway

WHEREAS pursuant to section 40 of the *Community Charter* and section 120 of the *Land Title Act* the Council may by bylaw close part of a highway to traffic and remove the dedication of that part of the highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council, before adopting this Bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic and remove the dedication of that portion of highway more particularly hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY HIGHWAY CLOSURE BYLAW NO. 4,
 2010.
- 2. ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as all that portion of road in District Lot 162, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Statutory Right of Way Plan 66149 containing 31.6m² (hereinafter called "the closed portion of road") shown outlined and described as Parcel A on Reference Plan prepared by R.E. Petersen, B.C.L.S., and deposited in the Land Title Office under Number BCP_______, a copy of which is hereunto annexed (hereinafter called "the plan") is hereby closed to all types of traffic.

3. The dedication of the closed portion of road as highway is removed.
