BYLAW NO. 12850

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain lands and improvements pursuant to section 224(1) and (2)(d) of the Community Charter

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BYLAW
 NO. 2, 2010.
- 2. Pursuant to section 224(1) and (2)(d) of the *Community Charter*, Council does hereby exempt from taxation under section 197(1)(a) of the said Act for the year 2011 the interest in municipal land and improvements of a non-profit organization that uses or occupies the land and improvements as a licensee or tenant of the City of Burnaby, namely, 7450 Meadow Avenue (Roll No. 6337-7450), 7528 Meadow Avenue (Roll No. 6337-7528), 5945 14th Avenue (Roll No. 4480-5945), 6069 14th Avenue (Roll No. 4480-6069) more particularly described as Lot 4, District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1249, Lot 78, District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 67510, Lot 6, District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 67510, occupied by the BURNABY & REGION ALLOTMENT GARDENS ASSOCIATION.
- 3. Pursuant to section 224(1) and (2)(d) of the *Community Charter*, Council does hereby exempt from taxation under section 197(1)(a) of the said Act for the year 2011 fifty percent of the interest in a municipal building of a non-profit organization that uses or occupies the building as a licensee or tenant of the City of Burnaby, namely, 9048 Stormont Avenue (Roll No. 3242-9048) more particularly described as Lot 9 except part in Statutory Right of Way Plan 26009, District Lot 14, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 12158, occupied by PACIFIC ASSISTANCE DOGS

SOCIETY, SAVE AND EXCEPT that portion of the improvements used for residential purposes and a proportionate area of the land as shown on plan annexed to Bylaw No. 10285, filed in the Land Title Office in New Westminster.
