BYLAW NO. 13265

A BYLAW respecting fees charged under the
Electrical Bylaw

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY ELECTRICAL BYLAW 1974, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2, 2013.**

2. Appendix "A" of Burnaby Electrical Bylaw 1974 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

<p>5. Temporary Saw Service:</p>	<p>Fee based on value of electrical installation (Minimum \$83.25)</p>
<p>6. Review of preliminary or modified drawings and specifications:</p>	<p>\$67.55/hour (minimum .5 of an hour)</p>
<p>7. Permit Fee to Record Work Done Without Permit and Inspection:</p> <p>Where electrical work has been carried out without a permit and a permit is accepted to approve and inspect the work after the fact, the fee shall be calculated under Section 2 based on the value of the electrical installation as estimated by the Chief Building Inspector at the time of application for the electrical permit (minimum \$125.25)</p>	
<p>8. Permit Fee Refund:</p> <p>Where no inspection has been performed under the permit, the refund will be 90% of the fee paid subject to a minimum non-refundable of \$150.00. No refunds will be given unless a written request is received by the Chief Building Inspector.</p>	
<p>9. Permit Extension:</p>	<p>\$105.60</p>

<p>12. Reinspection Fee:</p> <p>Where it has been determined by the Electrical Inspector that due to non-compliance with the provisions of this Bylaw or incomplete work reinspection is required</p> <p><i>Re-inspection fees subject to all applicable taxes</i></p>	<p>1st reinspection \$53 2nd reinspection \$227 3rd reinspection \$449 4th reinspection \$898 5th reinspection and thereafter \$1,124</p>
<p>13. Special Inspections:</p> <p>All applicable taxes will be added to special inspection fees</p> <p>(a) For an inspection requested by the owner or occupant but not required by the Bylaw</p> <p>(b) For an inspection outside the hours during which the offices of the City Hall are normally open</p> <p>(c) For an inspection that requires special arrangements because of length of time, frequency of inspection visits, location outside the City limits, construction techniques or otherwise</p> <p>(d) Strata title subdivision application inspections</p>	<p>\$86.65/hour or part thereof (\$86.65 minimum)</p> <p>\$487.45 plus \$124.60/hour or part thereof after the first four hours. Travel time included.</p> <p>\$86.65/hour or part thereof (\$86.65 minimum)</p> <p>\$192.35</p>

14. Permit Transfer or Assignment Fee: To record a change of contractor for a project	\$105.60
15. Copies of departmental records or drawings <i>Copy fees subject to all applicable taxes</i>	\$1.20 per page for copies 8.5 x 11 inches \$5.65 per page for copies 11 x 17 inches or larger

3. This Bylaw shall come into force on the first day of January 2014.
