## **BYLAW NO. 13395**

## A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment **Reserve Fund**

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$132,407,947.85 as at the 7th day of September 2014, calculated as follows:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 25, 2014.** 

2. The sum of \$52,335 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.

3. Should any of the said sum of \$52,335 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
