Council

met at 5 p.m.. There were present
Reverend Schon and Comte Pierre
Digne and Dr Dermoth & Shire

Minutes of the preceding meeting
of 14 Nov were read and approved.
It was moved by Comte Digne
seconded by Comte Shire and resolved
that the Clerk be instructed to
write to Thos Kidd M.P.P requesting him
to urge the Govt to pay the \$1000.
Gravel to which this district is
entitled.

In the matter of gravel
taken off Holden Land and used for
road purposes it was moved by
Comte Shire seconded by Comte Digne
and resolved that the Clerk be
instructed to write to Mr Beaton fact
subject to approval of Aubrey Brownson
our Solicitor. Comte Shire reported

on the continuation of the Guichon road
that owing to the absence of Mr keeper
he had so far taken no action.

Communication from
Westhope was read this was complaining
of the bad state near his place and it was
moved by Councillor McDermott seconded by Councillor
Byrne and Resolved that Councillor Stride be
authorized to have work done on same cost
not to exceed £15/- The matter of bad condition
of some part of Vanc road between the City
of New Westminster and the junction was
brought up and the Clerk instructed to urge
on the Tram Co the ballasting and leveling
of this road — The matter of opening a road
from the Royal Oak road to Guichon road was
brought up and it was resolved that Messrs
Ralph Robinson & Grinnell be employed to chop
a road through taking the section lines or
as near them as practicable A communication
from Mr McDonald was read This was in
the matter of the rebate on his taxes which
had been allowed him but he misunderstood
the matter and asked to have them returned
and the Clerk was instructed to inform him
that the Rebate had been allowed
It was moved by Councillor Byrne seconded by Councillor
Stride and Resolved that Henry Plester and
Goth keepers be authorized to build the
continuation of Guichon road @ 1/- per chain
and £2/- for a culvert required on a low part
of the road — It was moved by Councillor
Byrne seconded by Councillor Brine and Resolved
that settlers on the Vancouver road be allowed

to work out their road by on the
Corporation road under the direction of
Ralph Robinson - It was moved by Council
Hall & seconded by Council Shride and
resolved that Thos Rocklebank be
allowed to deepen the ditch on the
Vancouver road by No. 12 at his own
private cost he agreeing to hold this
Corporation harmless from any damage
or claim - The complaint as to the soft
places on 2nd Avenue was left to Council
McKernan & Shride to deal with.

at 3 o'clock p.m.
