Council
met at 5 p.m. There were present
Reverend Schou and Comrs Brine
Byrne and G. Dermott & Shide

Minutes of the preceding meeting
of 14th Nov were read and approved
It was moved by Comr Shide
sec by Comr Shide and resolved
that the Clerk be instructed to
write to Shos Nida M.P. requesting him
to urge the Govt to pay the £1000.
Grant to which this district is
entitled

In the matter of gravel
taken off Holden land and used for
road purposes it was moved by
Comr Shide sec by Comr Brine
and resolved that the Clerk be
instructed to write to Col. Bygone fact
subject to approval of Col. Lay Morrison
our Solicitor Comr Shide reported

on the continuation of the Guichon road that owing to the absence of Mr Decker he had so far taken no action

Communication from Mr Easthope was read this was complaining of the bad state near his place and it was moved by Counc McDermott sec by Counc Byrne and Resolved that Counc Stride be authorized to have work done on same cost not to exceed £100. The matter of bad condition of some part of Vauc road between the City of New Westminster and the junction was brought up and the Clerk instructed to urge on the Tram Co the ballasting and leveling of this road — The matter of opening a road from the Royal Oak road to Guichon road was brought up and it was resolved that Mess Ralph Robinson & Grimm be employed to chop a road through taking the section lines or as near there as practicable A Communication from Mrs McDermott was read This was in the matter of the rebate on her taxes which had been allowed her but she misunderstood the matter and asked to have them returned and the Clerk was instructed to inform her that the Rebate had been allowed

It was moved by Counc Byrne sec by Counc Stride and Resolved that Henry Plester and Gotkeeper be authorized to build the continuation of Guichon road @ 1 ft per chain and 12" for a culvert required on a low part of the road — It was moved by Counc Byrne sec by Counc Byrne and resolved that settlers on the Vancouver road be allowed

to work out their road way on the Corporation road under the direction of Ralph Robinson—It was moved by Council Hill secy Council Shide and resolved that Thos Rocklebank be allowed to deepen the ditch on the Vancouver road by No. 12 at his own private cost he agreeing to hold this Corporation harmless from any damage or claim—The complaint as to the roof places on 2nd Avenue was left to Counc McWormth + Shide to deal with.

It was resolved Alfred Smith be appointed rebuy Officer to hold the election next January that the place of holding same be public school house and that it be advertised one each in the Daily + Weekly Columbian and the Daily and weekly News Advertiser—The Council then adjourned to meet again in the same place on Saturday 15 inst at 3 o'clock pm.
