inspect Hastings road and report on work
required to be done before putting on
MacAdam.

It was moved by Councill Strader
seconded by Councill McDermott and
Resolved that the Clerk be instructed to
write to the W&G Tramway Co informing
them that their tram track on the
Vancouver road has not yet been ballasted
according to the agreement entered into
when permission was given them to build a
what is commonly known as the Short Line
and to request an early fulfillment of
the Agreement. In the matter of the
Bank or water trough not having

replaced by Mr R G Wellwood so
it was before he removed the supports
to it. It was Resolved that the
Clerk be instructed to write to Mr
Wellwood that if this work is not
properly done before the 29th instant
This Council will have it done at his
cost.

It was moved by Councillor

and resolved that the Rebate be
allowed on all days paid before the
15th October.

It was moved by Councillor
Shute seconded by Councillor McDermott
and Resolved that a Team and Wagon
under the supervision of Councillor
McDermott be employed to do the
work required on Mary street near Bakers
It was moved by Councillor McDermott
seconded by Councillor Hill and
Resolved that the Council
adjourn to meet again on Saturday
29th inst at the same hour in
the same place.
