Report of R P Sharpe the collector was read and it was resolved that it be recd & filed.

Communication from E M Wiltshire was read in which he complained that his land was wrongly assessed or well laid and the Clerk was instructed to inform Mr Wiltshire that the Council has no power to alter the assessment after it has been revised.

It was moved by Counc Stride

write to the W & V Tramway Co informing  
them that their train tracks on the  
Vancouver road has not yet been ballasted  
according to the Agreement entered into  
when permission was given them to build  
what is commonly known as the Short Line  
and to request an early fulfillment of  
the Agreement. In the matter of the  
Danks or watering trough not having

 to it. It was Resolved that the  
 Clerk be instructed to write to Mr  
 Wellwood that if this work is not  
 properly done before the 29<sup>th</sup> inst

 and resolved that the Rebate be  
 allowed on all days paid before the  
 15<sup>th</sup> October

It was moved by Counc  
 Stude seconded by Counc McVermott  
 and Resolved that a Secum and Wagon  
 under the supervision of Counc  
 McVermott be employed to do the  
 work required on Mary street near Bakers

It was moved by Counc McVermott  
 seconded by Counc Hill and  
 Resolved that the Council  
 adjourn to meet again on Saturday  
 29<sup>th</sup> inst at the same hour in  
 the same place
