Council met at 3 p.m.

Present Reeve Below Reeve in the  
Chair and Councillors Byrne Stile

adopted. Communication from the City Gaol  
in reply to the request to have Messrs  
A de Weerd Haszard and Prestie  
placed on the Commission of the Peace  
for Burnaby was read and it was  
resolved that it be received and filed

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The usual report from R P Sharpe  
Collector was read and it was resolved  
that it be read & filed.

The quarterly  
report from H A Eastman Auditor  
was read and it was resolved that  
it be read & filed and the  
recommendations offered be adopted.  
It was resolved that \$15= be allowed  
Ed Wigand for removing large cedar  
tree on North arm road. It was moved  
by Council Clerk read by Council M W  
and resolved that Application be  
invited by two insertions of Advertisement  
in Daily Columbian and News Advertiser  
for Loans on real property held and  
used for farming purposes and free  
from any liens Applications to be  
before 12 o'clock 5 Nov. It was  
moved by Council Clerk read by Council  
McKinnott and resolved that

Chas Farrand be paid \$10= work on Barn.  
The revised tenders invited for  
work on Hastings road were opened  
and it was moved by Council M W  
read by Council Clerk and resolved  
that Wm Stewart tender to do the  
work for \$30= be accepted. A certificate  
from Council Clerk of Coquihalla  
stating that Contract for protection  
work to Brunette Bridge had been  
done according to Specification  
was read and it was moved by Council  
McKinnott read by Council Clerk and

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resolved that \$125: the amount of the Contract be paid to the Contractor Sydney Stride and that \$25: be applied for from the Coquihalla Council

The tenders for digging ditch and making road alongside Lot 155A which had been laid over from previous meeting were taken up for consideration and it was moved by Councillor Byrne seconded by Councillor McKernott and resolved that John Woollards tender to do the work according to the specifications for four ( $\text{ft}^2$ ) Dollars per chain be accepted.

It was moved by Councillor Byrne seconded by Councillor Stride and resolved that Kennedy Bros bill for \$13.95 for Ads in the weekly Columbian be pd. also that John Edwards be paid \$101.55 (being order to Repmiles \$13.85 and Last sum \$87.50) It was moved by Councillor Hill seconded by Councillor Stride and resolved that tenders be invited by Ads in the weekly Columbian for hauling broken stone on Hastings road 300 cuyds more or less rock to be spread on road where directed between Whiting's & Cowling's logging Camp the longest haul will not exceed  $\frac{3}{4}$  of one mile tenders to state price per yard for further particulars apply to L C Hill deer lake tender to be in not later than 12 o'clock noon 3<sup>rd</sup> Nov Some of the Govt reserves in this District having been divided up and sold in small parcels and there being no plan of this subdivision in the Clerk Office he was

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instructed to apply to Messrs Burnet & Burnet P.S.S. Vancouver requesting them to make these subdivisions on the District maps. It was moved by Councillor Stiles sec by Councillor McPherson and resolved that Messrs Hill and Marjoram take levels on the Royal Oak road with a view to having the heavy grade on some easier. It was moved by Councillor McPherson sec by Councillor Stiles and resolved that Councillor Payne be authorized to have some repairs that are needed on the North Arm road done. It was moved by Councillor Stiles sec by Councillor Payne and resolved that this Council adjourn to meet again in the same place on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> Nov. at 3 p.m.
