for Burnaby was read and it was
resolved that it be received & filed

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The usual report from R P Sharpe collector was read and it was resolved that it be received & filed

The quarterly report from H A Eastman Auditor was read and it was resolved that it be received & filed and the recommendations offered be adopted. It was resolved that \$15- be allowed E W Dyne for removing large cedar tree on North Main road. It was moved by Comr Hill sec by Comr McD and resolved that Applications be invited by two insertions of Advertisement in Daily Columbian and News Advertiser for Loans on real property held and used for farming purposes and free from any lien. Applications to be before 12 o'clock 5 Nov. It was moved by Comr Hill sec by Comr McErmott and resolved that

Chas Farrand be paid \$10- work on 2nd corner. The revised Quakers minutes for work on Hastings road were opened and it was moved by Comr McD sec by Comr Stride and resolved that Wm Stewarts tender to do the work for \$30- be accepted. A Certificate from Comr Austin of Coquitlam stating that Contract for protection work to Drumette Bridge had been done according to Specification was read and it was moved by Comr McErmott sec by Comr Stride and

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resolved that \$125⁰⁰ the Amount of the Contract be paid to the Contractor Sydney Stride and that \$75⁰⁰ be applied for from the Coquitlam Council

The Tenders for digging ditches and making road alongside Lot 155A which had been laid out from previous meeting, were taken up for consideration and it was moved by Counc Byrne sec by Counc McErmott and resolved that John Woodlands Tender to do the work according to the Specifications for four (4) Dollars per chain be accepted It was moved by Counc Byrne sec by Counc Stride and resolved that Jennedys Bros Bill for \$13.⁹⁵ for Ads in the weekly Columbian be pd. also that John Dauds be paid \$101.²⁵ (being order to Rep Mills \$17.⁷⁵ and Jas Hunt \$87.⁵⁰) It was moved by Counc Hill sec by Counc Stride and resolved that Tenders be invited by Ads in the weekly Columbian for hauling broken Stone on Hookings road 300 cu. yds more or less rock to be spread on road where directed between Whittings + Cowlings Logging Camp the longest haul will not exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ of one mile Tenders to state price per Yard for further particulars apply to L C Hill deer lake Tenders to be in not later than 12 o'clock noon 3rd Nov Some of the Govt reserves in this district having been divided up and sold in small parcels and there being no plan of this subdivision in the Clerk Office he was

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instructed to apply to Messrs Burnet &
 Burnet P. S. Vancouver requesting
 them to make these subdivisions
 on the District maps It was moved by
 Council Stride sec by Council McWhinnott
 and resolved that Messrs Hill and
 Hargrave take levels on the Royal Oak
 road with a view to having the
 heavy grade on same erased
 It was moved by Council McWhinnott
 sec by Council Hill and resolved that
 Council Ryne be authorized to have
 some repairs that are needed on the
 North Elm road done It was moved
 by Council Hill sec by Council
 Ryne and resolved that this
 Council Adjourn to meet again
 in the same place on Saturday
 3rd Nov. at 3 p.m.
