read and ordered to be paid & filed
and that \$60- the Amk awarded
Breuchley be paid to him

It was moved by Counc Byrne
sec by Counc McDermoth and
resolved that West & M Breuchley be
allowed rebate in payment of their
rates - The Clerk was instructed
to request the Tram & Telephone Cos
to move their posts off Breuchleys land
without delay the position of the poles
to be left with Counc Slade

It was resolved that Counc Byrne McDermoth & Slade
be a committee to contract for and supervise the
erection of Breuchleys fence and the filling up of the
ditch It was resolved that Joseph Wilmamut
be paid \$25- Council then adjourned
