Council met at 8 pm -

Present

Rene Schon in the chair and  
 Council Hill McDermott & Stride  
 The minutes of meeting held 29 Sep  
 were read and adopted - Senders  
 invited for some work were then opened  
 and Charles Roberts - Sender to close cut  
 the brush on Bootings road between the  
 ditches at six cents per chain of roadway  
 and Whiting Bros senders to make the 24  
 chains of road in lot 549, at \$3 per chain  
 were accepted. In the matter of the senders  
 ready for breaking stones on Bootings road  
 It was moved by Council Hill and by Council  
 Mc Dermott and resolved that Revised  
 senders be invited for the work and Council  
 Mc Dermott agreed to be at the Burnaby  
 school house on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> inst at 9 am,  
 for the purpose of showing what was  
 required of the senders.

It was moved by  
 Council Mc Dermott and by Council Stride and  
 Resolved that sufficient labor be hired  
 under the direction of Council Mc Dermott to  
 clear the ditch on third Avenue between  
 fill up the cuts and put in a small  
 culvert on a low place in the road.  
 It was moved by Council Mc Dermott and  
 by Council Stride and resolved that the  
 Clerk be instructed to fix the Corporate  
 Seal on all contracts entered into by  
 the Council (See 82 Municipality 1891)
