It was moved by Council Smith sec by Council Byrne & resolved that the Reeve with Council Stride together with the mover and recorder of this Resolution be a Committee to view

Central Park road next Saturday at 3 o'clock. It was resolved that the Clerk be instructed to invite tenders by Advertisement in the News Advertiser & Columbian for the construction of a ditch alongside the new road in lots 166 & 166A for the extension of it Ave from its present terminus westerly to the Hastings rd & for the building of a bridge on the Johnston road across the first Ravine east of the Hastings road. Tenders to be in not later than 4 p.m. 26 inst.

Communication from Hoagson & Wapser Vancouver was read. This stated that they intended shortly to publish a Directory of Vancouver and suggested that Burnaby have a description of the Municipality published and it was moved by Council Smith sec by Council Byrne & resolved that the Reeve be authorized to have a description inserted the cost not to exceed \$5.

Council Sprott was authorized to have a team & Waggon hired for 3 days to haul gravel.

The Council then adjourned to meet again on Saturday the 26 inst at 4 o'clock.
