The Council met in the usual place at 3 o'clock afternoon of Saturday 14 inst 1895

Present the Reeve and all the Councilors

The minutes ~~text~~ of last meeting &c. the one of the 5th ult were read and adopted as read

The Reeve read a letter from Major Townley which stated that the Major had forwarded the Reeves letter to the proper quarter, and had no doubt but that proceeding would be taken to thoroughly investigate the matter and it was resolved that the letter be received & filed

The question of granting a Slaughter house license to Gaudin & Co was taken up and after some discussion the matter was laid over till next meeting

that Gaudin & Co might have an opportunity to read the conditions on which only a license could be granted and express their willingness or otherwise to comply with these conditions.

A communication from the Clerk of Vancouver City enclosing a resolution of the Council of that City in the matter of establishing a Weekly public market there was read and it was resolved that this Council is in favor of having a day set apart on which a Public market will be held in Vancouver City and that the communication be received & filed.

It was resolved that Councillors Stride & Byrne be authorized to deal with the Central Park road and have necessary work done.

That Counc. Sprott be authorized to have some repairs made on the Ledger road cost not to exceed \$50.

That Counc. Stride & McDermott see as to the best way of rodding St Avenue of the stagnant water on same.

That Counc. Sprott see about the small job needed on the Hosking road and that Councillors Byrne & Stride see about works needed on the Vancouver road.

The Council adjourned to meet again at 2.30 in the afternoon of St Saturday 21st inst. in the same place.
