

<sup>14</sup> Sept. 1895

The Council met at 4 p.m. of Saturday  
14 Sept. 1895 in room No 1 Masonic Hall

New Westminster City

There were present Rees Schou in the chair  
and Councillors M'Dermott Byrne Smith  
Spott & Stride. The minutes of the last  
meeting being the one held on the 31 Aug  
were read and adopted.

It was moved by Counc. Byrne seconded  
Counc. Spott & resolved that the clerk be  
instructed to write to Agreement and  
Specifications for the Burseroad the Contract  
if given to be completed within 60 days

The tenders received for the making of the  
Burseroad were opened and after they had  
been considered the tender of Ernest Easthope  
to do the work at \$2.25 per chain was accepted

The following payments were ordered

- \$ 25= W.B.M. Kempster Secy. R.A. & I. Society
- 40= H.I. Orzmond of Corduroy Byrn road
- 21.10 R.P. Sharp Collector Commission: Stamps
- 75= Westminster Hardw Co 1 Auger
- 6= H. Plewitt Re Good Appeal
- 525= to be paid on Temporary Loan Note

Bill \$215 Robert E. Julian Prov. Police and  
communication from Capt. Telleurigh S. M.  
were read and it was resolved that they be  
referred to our Solicitor for advice thereon

It was moved by Counc. Spott seconded  
Counc. Smith & resolved that W.H. Ledger  
Pathmaster N.Y. be authorized to employ a  
team for about (5) days work on the road.

It was left to Councillors M'Dermott & Stride  
to authorize Mr W. Wrennith pathmaster

to have Stone hauled onto the Douglas  
road when necessary

It was moved by Counc Smith & Stride  
and resolved that the Clerk get the  
Receipt book needed by the Pathmaster

It was resolved that Counc McDermott  
be authorized to order \$11,250 poor relief for  
Walmsey & Family. It was moved

by Counc Smith sec by Counc Stride  
resolved that the matter of ascertaining  
the Amt. earned on the Easthope Contract  
for Corduroy on the Byrne road be left  
to Counc Byrne & Easthope & W J Dugloun  
Counc Stride & Spott were requested to  
call on Chas Farraud and urge him  
to complete his contract

The Recer made a  
short report showing the favorable  
condition of the finances of the Corporation

The Clerk was instructed to have  
the descriptions of the North Arm road  
and the extension of the Duchow road

advertised in the St Gazette  
At Mr John Wiggins request he was  
relieved from the Office of Pathmaster  
in ward 1 and Mr John Woodard was  
appointed in his stead.

The Council Adjourned to meet  
again on Saturday 28 inst at 4 p.m.
