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requesting a donation from this Corporation - was read and it was moved by Counc Byrne seely Counc Smith and resolved that \$25⁰⁰ be given - It was moved by Counc Smith seely Counc Byrne and resolved that Counc Smith be authorized to employ what labor is needed to clear the Johnston road - A communication was read from Chas E Hope agent for J E Pickles in the matter of alleged assessment of land owned by E E Pickles in lot 156 with the quantity being 68 and not 120 as stated in the Assessment Notices of 1893 & 1894 and claiming a return of the difference and it was resolved that the letter be received and referred to H A Coatsman the Assessor and that Mr Hope be informed of the action taken. - A communication from A Dewhurst was read and it was resolved that his request cannot be granted It was reported to the Council that Messrs Killey & Laird law had placed an obstruction on the road known as the North road by building fence across same and it was resolved that the matter be referred to Counc Slide to report on. - A communication was read from McQuide & Whiteside in the matter of E E Coatsman taking Condemn of off lot 160 the property of their Clients Hoy & Maratt and the communication was ordered to be read file. It was moved by Counc Smith seely Counc Mc Dermott that Mr H A Coatsman be appointed to audit the accounts and Vouchers of the Corporation for the first 6 months of this year The following persons were appointed as path masters in ward 1
