J. McCleughan having thrown up his contract to make part of 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue it was resolved that the contract be awarded to Chas Farand the next tender communication from Mr. Robson Secy of New Westminster Board of Trade would this be as to the advisability of some of the District Municipalities being represented on the Board. And the same was authorized to write to Mr. Robson Secy N. in this matter.
