W. Little's Co. tender to do this work on the Vancouver road for thirty (30) five cents per cub yard and Connolly & Nicholson tender to do the work on the Hastings road for ninety (90) cents per cub yard he accepted J. McCleughan having thrown up his contract to make part of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue it was resolved that the contract be awarded to Chas. Farn and the next General Communication from D. Robson Sect<sup>y</sup> of New Westminster Board of Trade was read this was as to the advisability of some of the District Municipalities being represented on the Board. And the Clerk was authorized to write to D. Robson Sect<sup>y</sup> in this matter.

It was resolved that the Statutory meeting of the Board of Licensing Commissioners on Wednesday 11 Dec be held in the Public School house at 3/5 in the afternoon and that this meeting be advertised in one issue of the Daily Columbian Newspaper and that A. Smiles be Clerk.
