A communication from Mr Morrison was

read this was in the matter of the obstruction

that had been placed on the houth road & it

was resolved that it be left in Mr Morrison's

hands to be dealt with

The Clerk reported he had not written to Ali G Cross, as he was absent fishing but that he had written to W S Gore Deputy Commissioner of Land & Works and read a reply from the Deputy Commissioner stating that the time given to the Lessee of small holdings in Burnaby had been extended to 31st December next.

Councillors Spott & Stude reported on the extra claimed by Fred Chrusell on his contract for sec 344 boundary road that 50[¢] per foot be allowed and the report was read & adopted.

The further consideration of C Farr and his contract was on motion of Counc Stude & Byrne laid over.

Councillor Spott reported that he had let the contract for 2 chains of Corduroy on the Whiting road to Whiting Birs for \$11- and the report was received and adopted. It was moved by Counc Mc Dermott sec'd by Counc Spott & resolved that Counc Byrne Smith & Stude be appointed a Committee to ascertain report what was due on the Easthope Abandoned Contract to furnish and lay Corduroy on part of the Byrne road & road at right angles to same.

It was moved by Counc Smith sec'd by Counc Spott & resolved that Chas Hollands engagement as Constable terminate next Wednesday night. It was moved by Counc Byrne sec'd by Counc Smith & resolved that the resolution requiring 75% to be retained for a month when settling up with Contractors shall not apply in cases where properly signed pay rolls are produced. - Howell Roberts having

to advertise for tenders for same
It was moved by Counc Byers secy
Counc Mc Dermott & resolved that our
Solicitor Aulay Morrison be requested to
write to Jas W Gibbons with a view of
some satisfactory arrangement being made
as to his contract to make sections
5-6+8 of Boundary road
The Clerk was instructed to invite
Mr Shos Broserop to attend next meeting
of the Council when the question of
making the road asked for by him will
be taken up for consideration
The Council then adjourned to
meet again in same place on Saturday
24 inst at 4 pm.
