resolved that tenders be invited for hauling  
about 50 yards gravel from Callmond street  
and spreading same on Hastings road 16  
yds of gravel opposite Hardys and the rest  
on the hill in place where Corduroy is not  
covered The Council then adjourned  
to meet again on Monday 20 inst at  
4 o'clock in the afternoon
