of \$33.50 was ordered to be paid —

Councillors Byrne & Stride  
were appointed a Special Committee to  
make arrangements for having the abandoned  
Coastwise Contract for Corduroy on the Byrne  
road completed and Henry Drimney was  
allowed an extension of time to the 31<sup>st</sup> Aug on his  
contract — A communication from  
W D Bailey, secy of the local committee for  
making a new School District was read this  
was an invitation to the Rees & Councillors  
to attend the adjourned meeting to be held on 22  
inst and it was resolved that as many attend as  
can consistently to do consistently do so  
In the matter of the obstruction of the North road

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It was moved by Council Byrne sec'd by Council Stride & resolved that the Reeve & councillors Mr Dermott, Smith be a special committee to meet and confer with the Committee from Council of Coquihlam district on next Saturday the 27<sup>th</sup> inst at 10 o'clock in the forenoon on the north road at Kilby & Laidlaw's place — It was moved by Council Smith sec'd by Council Sprout & resolved that the Clerk be instructed to make out the needed lists of those liable to perform Statute labor.

Letter was read from John Sprout P.W. Supt of roads & the clerk was instructed to reply that the Boundary road was progressing and expected to be completed before long — Communication from

C. B. McKenzie Sec't of the P.A. & S. society stating that the Grant from the Municipality would be applied the same as last year was read and it was resolved that the Clerk be instructed to inform the Sect<sup>s</sup> that this disposition of the Grant would be satisfactory. — It was resolved that the Reeve & Council Sprout attend the hearing in the County Court of the Ford appeal from the Court of Revision on behalf of this Corporation.
