

The Council met in the usual place
at 2.30 in the afternoon of Saturday
21st Dec 1890

Present Revere Schou in the
Chair & Councillors Byrne McDermott
Smith Spott & Shide The minutes of the
last meeting being the one held on the
14th inst were read and adopted as read

Young Spott Reported that he had let
a Contract to Whiting & Sons for abt 300 ft
of 8 ft corduroy on Ledger road for \$50=

It being reported to the Council
that Saml Walmsley had died in
Bournemouth in destitute circumstances. It
was moved by Counc. Spott & 2^d by Counc. Shide
& resolved that David Murchie be employed
to conduct the funeral for \$25= and
It was moved by Counc. Smith & 2^d by Counc.
Spott & resolved that \$20= be given to the
Widow Anne Walmsley for the benefit of
herself & the two children Mr. Eli Sanders
reported that Mrs Joseph Wintermute had
stopped up a culvert on the Hoatings road
not far from the southerly limits of the
District

21 December 1895

It was moved by Counc^r McDermott
seconded by Counc^r Byrne resolved that
the Clerk write to Mr Spitemute
about it.

It was resolved that a
Public meeting of the Sappers be held
next Saturday from 3 to 6 in the afternoon
and that the Clerk ask for the use of
the New Westminster City Hall to hold the
meeting in

That H A Eastman be
appointed to audit the accounts of
the Corporation up to the 31st Dec 1895

That Alfred Smith be returning Officer
and the Election of Rate Commissioners be
held in the school house

That the Clerk write to the
Council of New Westminster and Vancouver
Cities and the District of South Vancouver
with a view to taking concerted action
as to enforcing the Wide Dike Act

It was moved by
Counc^r Spitt seconded by Counc^r McDermott
resolved that a vote thanks be tendered
Mr Eli Sanders for his kindness to the
deceased Sam^l Walsley and his Widow
and Children

The Council then
Adjourned till 28th Dec^r at 2 o'clock
in the afternoon
