A communication from AM Vreche CMC Mission District was read this was to inform Burnaby that a Petition had been forwarded to the Dominion Govt requesting a reduction of the charge on Govt Lands from \$5 to \$1 per acre and it was resolved that we are in favor of the petition

A communication from Geo Martin CMC South Vancouver was read this was inquiry as to whether this Council had taken any steps to enforce the wide fire Act and it was resolved that we request South Van - to correspond with Vancouver City Govt in this matter and Burnaby Council would write to the New Westminster City Council to ascertain what assistance might be expected from them as to enforcing this useful Act

Communication from St. Jean complaining of the water from the higher lands carried by the ditches constructed emptying onto his land parts of lot 79 was read & it was resolved that Mr Hill be requested to remove any logs from the Dam in the Burnette river and that the Council visit the place to what it is best to do

Communication from Mr St. Swigg was read this was in the matter of the road as the westerly boundary of this District between the Vancocks and Hastings roads and it was resolved that Mr Hargard be instructed to go over the proposed road and report thereon at next meeting of this Council and that the Clerk be instructed to inform Mr St. Swigg

of the action taken by the Council Mr Hargard reported on the nature of the line on south side lot 75 with a view to make a road thereon that for about 20 chains a road could be made easily but from there to Murchie's road the line went along some heavy grades and over some deep gullies but that a small trail from Murchie's road to Burnaby Lake could easily be built. It was resolved that Mr Hargard's report be read that his bill be paid but that no action be taken until the Government is made up

Letter from Sydney Stide on behalf of
 Coquille Council was read This was done by
 Burnaby paying half the cost of removing
 the slide that occurred on the North road
 last January And it was moved by
 Council Smith sec by Council Byrne and
 resolved that \$50 that being half the
 cost be paid It was moved by
 Council Byrne sec by Council Stide & resolved
 that Statute labor be imposed as part
 of the taxation in this District and
 Council Byrne gave notice that at next
 meeting of this Council he would ask
 leave to introduce an Amendment
 to the Burnaby Assessment By-law
 1895 The Council by resolution
 adjourned to meet again in same place
 at 3 p.m. Saturday 9th Mar.
