It was moved by Councillor McDermott
seconded by Councillor Stride resolved
that Mr Morrison be requested to report
what further action has been taken in the
matter of the obstruction on the North road
It was moved by Councillor Smith sec by Councillor
McDermott resolved that we accept Fred

Thrusells tender to construct section of the
Boundary road he finding satisfactory Bond
for \$100- to complete the work according to the
Specifications of same and to complete the
work to the satisfaction of this Council before
the 1st of Dec and that 25% of the amount be
retained for 30 days after the work has been
finished & accepted — Chas Macrop being
present addressed the Council in the matter
of a proposed road through a portion of lot 35-
Group I and after the question had been
discussed it was moved by Councillor Stride sec by
Councillor Smith resolved that Mr Andrew Hazard
be instructed to trace the line of the suggested
road giving the central line thereof — It was
also moved by Councillor Smith sec by Councillor
McDermott resolved that an Advertisement
be inserted once each in the Daily Weekly
Columbian stating that tenders will be rec'd
up to 31 Inst for making suggested road 12 ft

wide and crowned 1 foot along centre
 The Clerk was instructed to notify the
 Path masters that have been appointed
 That the Council for the ward in which
 they are path master will give them any
 information they may need and that the
 Councillor for each Ward arrange the
 time and place and where the work shall be
 done and report on same — A Communication
 from Rev Mr Fayard O.M. I was read this
 was a complaint that lot 53 was still
 assessed as wild land and the Clerk was
 instructed to inform him that when his
 Appeal to the Court of Revision was called no
 one appeared on his behalf nor was any evidence
 submitted — The Court sustained the Assessment
 as to the land being Wild land but reduced
 the Valuation from \$60 to \$55 per acre
 A Communication from Albert J Hill as
 to furnishing this Corporation with a
 book of tracings of all the Registered
 subdivisions of lands in this District was
 read and it was Resolved that the
 Communication be received & referred to next
 meeting to be dealt with

It was resolved that
 Councillors Smith & Slade be a committee
 to see about the Post office contract for
 Concordroy

It was moved by Councillor Smith
 seconded by Councillor Slade & resolved that the
 Board of Licensing Commissioners for this
 Municipality be the 7 Deve Councillors
 Sprott Smith & Launcelot Gunn &
 John Woollard two Justices of the Peace

It was agreed that the Reeve and
Councillors Stride & Sprott on next Thursday
visit and inspect the Bridging on & Throssell's
1 Contract — The North Am road Bylaw
was introduced and read a first time

The Council then Adjourned to meet
again on Saturday the ^{31st inst at 4 p.m.}
