shall have due care and consideration as
requested by the resolution passed by
the meeting of Ratepayers held in this City
Joseph Osborne who was present informed the

and it was moved by Councillor Payne

the job of deepening the ditch be
auctioned off on Wednesday next
at 2 o'clock p.m. at Mr Robson's place
on the Vancouver road.

be instructed to have an advertisement
inserted in the Columbian
inviting Applications for the Office
of Assessor for this District.
Applicant to state qualifications and
manner in which he proposes to do the
Assessing. Application to be in on or
before 8th February.

& Resolved that Councillor Smith be
authorized to buy a dozen chairs
for use in Council room.
