The report of Eastman the Assessor  
in the matter of the complaint of Mr Slope Agh  
for Mr Pickles that the area of lot 156 had

A communication from Graham Wulffson of Vancouver was read this was to inform the Council that he had been duly appointed German Consul for the Mainland of N.C. and it was resolved that it be read & filed. The report from the Collector was read & file. The Agreement between the Corporation & Gillary Bros to allow Gillary Bros the use of a certain road and the ditch alongside the Byrne road for logging purposes was taken up for consideration - after being discussed & amended it was moved by Councillor Smith secy by Councillor Byrne & resolved that the Agreement be signed by the Reeve & Clerk and have the Corporate Seal affixed thereto.

It was moved by Councillor Byrne secy by Councillor Stride & resolved that the Postmasters be notified of their appointments and that John Marchie be appointed postmaster of beat 5 ward 1.

It was moved by Councillor McDermott secy by Councillor Sporth & resolved that Councillor McDermott be authorized to order \$10 more poor relief for Walmsley and Yarmill. It was resolved that Eli Zanders & Welch & Jesse Love be appointed postmasters in Ward III and that John Keefer, Ralph Robinson & Lancelot Lummer, Ernest Easthope & Joseph Wintermute be appointed for Ward II. It was resolved that Councillor Byrne & Smith be appointed a committee to attend to having the necessary Statute Labor rates paid. The Council then adjourned to meet again on Tuesday 2 July at 8 o'clock in the afternoon.
