30 March 1890

Council met at 8 pm all members
present

The minutes of meeting held on 23 March
were read and adopted

L. D. Winternute bill \$9.20 for
putting 234ds gravel on Douglas road
was read and ordered to be paid

Levi Morris bill \$10. laid over from
last meeting was considered and ordered
to be paid

Reeve read a letter he had received
from the Clerk of Vancouver City on the
subject of the consideration

of a road through
Hastings Township to connect with the
Douglas road and it was resolved that
the letter be read & filed

The tenders read for the improvement
of Hastings road were opened and
Herbert Dilleys tender to lay Corduroy
as called for at the rate of \$5.50 per chain
was accepted. The work to be completed
inside of 30 days

A. J. Hills plan of road through lot 166
and part of lot 164 together with
description of same was laid before
the Council and it was resolved that it
be received and taken up for consideration at
next meeting. Mr Hill was further
instructed to plant corner posts at any
and all divisions from the old road & fences

The Statute Labor By-law passed the
second reading passed through Committee
and was reported complete with
amendment

30 March 1895

Councillor Spott reported that Ralph Rhinon had broken 37 cwt of road metal and it was resolved that it be left to Council Stride to see to having same spread here report action taken at next meeting

Communication from the Collector enclosing one from C.T.P. was read and it was resolved that they be handed to the Corporation

Collector for him to deal with
 Councillor McDermoth gave notice that at next meeting of the Council he would ask leave to

introduce a Temporary Loan Bill
 The Council adjourned to meet again in same place on Saturday 6 April at 3 o'clock p.m.
