communication from R D Sharp collector
was read this enclosed letter from
CP&R Co making an offer of payment
of post due taxes for which they are
liable and it was resolved that
the offer be accepted.

The Collector stated in his letter
that 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ Acres of lot 25 had been entered
on his roll and he requested permission

to remedy the error which was
resolved that he be authorized to make
the necessary alterations in his roll.

The Clerk was instructed to request
the Collector to hand in by next
meeting a statement of collections and

back book showing the same.
The Clerk was instructed to enquire
from the Solicitor and obtain his opinion

as to the power of this Corporation
to collect arrears of road tax also as
to whether taxes could be collected
on timber lease holds from the lessee.

It was resolved that the Court of
Revision sit on the 20 May next and
the Clerk was instructed to advertise
the same as required by law, also to
apply to Multnomah City Council for
permission to the court of Revision
to hold the court in City Hall on that date.

The Statute Labor Day law was
reconsidered read a third time and
passed.

and it was ordered that the Corporate Seal be affixed and that it be advertised as required by law — The Temporary Loans Bylaw, was introduced and read a first second time — The Clerk was instructed to request the Collector to hand in at next meeting of the Council a statement of amount collected by him during this year and the Bank book made up to date.

It was resolved that County McDermott see to the reported dangerous standing trees on Cumberland road and that Council Byne be authorized to have a tree cut down the North Arm road.

The Council then adjourned to meet again in the same place on Saturday the 25th inst at 2 o'clock p.m.
