Louis Claude Hills report in the matter of the logs in Burnaby Lake was read and it was moved by Counc Byrnes secly Counc Smith & resolved that Evans Coleman Evans be written to in the matter of the damage from overflow from Burnaby lake caused by their logs in the lake and informed that it was necessary this should be attended to without delay and some action taken to remedy the evil complained of

The consideration of communication from Herbert Gileey & Shos Mars was laid over

It was moved by Counc Smith secly Counc Byrnes & resolved that so many of the Council as possible, start at 8 o'clock Am of Wednesday next to view some of the roads & to improvements needed and so on  
Communication from Chf. Comm<sup>r</sup> of L & C was read this states that the Govt had been pleased to grant \$1000. to this Municipality to aid in the construction of a road along the Western boundary of this District from the false creek road on the south to the Hoskins road on the north

Messrs Cwigg & Mackon who were present were heard advocating the construction of this road It was moved by Counc Byrne sec by Counc Spott and resolved that we are in favor of this road being made and it was moved by Counc Spott sec by Counc Byrne & resolved that Mr Hoagland be authorized to hire 2 men and clear out the line of the proposed road planting stakes thereon every quarter of a mile

Statute Laborers By-law was read and passed in first reading

It was moved by Counc Smith sec by Counc Byrne & resolved that Counc Spott be empowered to offer Joseph Wintimate \$-140 per cubic yd for gravel hauled and spread on the road as directed

It was moved by Counc Spott sec by Counc Byrne & resolved that any settler who wishes to do so can buck up stone on some spot handy to a road no pieces to be too large to pass through a 22 inch ring The Council agreeing to pay for same at the rate of \$1.50 per cubic yard

The Council then adjourned to meet again in same place on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> inst at 3 o'clock p.m.
