The Council met in the Clerk's Office on Saturday 1st Aug 1896 at 2 pm.

All the members of the Council were present.

The minutes of last meeting 18 July were read and adopted as read. Counc Smith reported that he had talked with Mrs Cherry and that she had agreed to board lodge room for Mr Elders for \$4- per month and it was moved by Counc McDermott sec by Counc Stride resolved that the report be adopted and cheque for \$4- be drawn and signed.

It was moved by Counc Smith sec by Counc Sprott resolved that \$60 Sixty dollars be granted to the St Mary's Hospital in New Westminster City (see 65)

Counc Robertson was granted leave of absence for the rest of the meeting.

A communication from Jno Woollard was read. The letter stated that it was reported that the new slaughter house near the City limits would be drained into a ditch and thereby pollute a running stream but as no ground for complaint existed at present no action was taken.
