It was moved by Council Smith seconded by Council McDermott & resolved that Mrs Laporte License to carry on a Slaughter house in this district be not renewed until the requirements of our Medical Health Officer had been complied with

The Clerk was instructed to forward the Medical Health Officer's report to the Provincial Board of Health

The matter of the damage done to several of the roads in the District by the late heavy rains was discussed and it was moved by Council Byrne seconded by Council Sprott & resolved that it be left to a committee of Councilors Stride Smith & McDermott to have done what is necessary

Council Smith was authorized to have some necessary work on North rd done
