The Council met in the usual place at 3 O'clock in the afternoon of Monday 11 May 1896

Present - the Reeve in the chair and all the Councillors

The minutes of last meeting being read & approved
It was resolved that Alfred Hies Bill \$22.50 laid over from last meeting be paid That Bill for Luncheon of Court of Revision² and H A Eastmans Bill \$5.40 laid over be paid

It was resolved that the Clerk be instructed to write to the Tramway Co requesting them to replace the planks on the Tram line and ballast & grade the road between the rails.

to Gilley Bros requesting them to put in the stone at the mouth of the Byrne road ditch as called for in the Agreement made with them to Dr R E Walter requesting him to see about the condition of the points Slaughter house in Burnaby

Councillors McDermott & Smith agreed to go to Gilley's Dairy farm on the North road next Monday and look there the plans & specifications of the road along Dr Gilley's fence they also agreed to call at the Royal Columbian Hospital for the purpose of seeing the sick man Chase and report to next meeting of Council

for the purpose of obtaining gravel
to put on the roads

It was resolved that the Rev & Council
D. Proth be a committee to see what
work is needed on the Hastings road
The following Communications were
received & filed

From the Clerk of New Westminster
City stating that permission had been
given to hold the Bunnaly Court of
Revision in the City Hall
From A. W. McKenzie Secty RA & Society
thanking the Council for the promise
of a donation of \$25.00 to the Prize List of
the Society

From the C.M.E. of Coquitlam
stating that the Action proposed in
the matter of the North road is fully
satisfactory to that Council

The Wide Six Bylaw was read a
second time. The rules of order were
suspended and it was read a third time
passed — The Council then Adjourned
till Saturday 2³ inst. at 3 p.m.
