prepare plan of South road showing also
true road limits at a cost not exceeding
\$450 to be divided between Burnaby &
Coquitlam Municipalities

The question of
opposing the Consolidated Railway & Light Co's
Bill now before the Provincial Legislative
Assembly was taken into consideration
and it was moved by Counc Smith
2ed by Counc Stride & resolved that the
Reeve and Clerk be instructed to sign
and affix the Corporate Seal to a Petition
protesting against the passing of the Bill
in its present shape,

Also that the
Reeve and Councillor Sprott be a
Delegation to go to Victoria next Tuesday
to press for necessary amendments
