

The Council met at 3 o'clock, in the afternoon of Saturday 18 April 1896. Present Reeve Schon in the chair and Councillors Stride McDermott and Smith — The minutes of last meeting (Hinst), were read and adopted — It was moved by Counc Smith sec by Counc McDermott & resolved that the Reeve be requested to arrange with Aulay Morrison Solicitor for him to attend the Court of Revision on behalf of this Corporation.

The clerk was instructed to write to the CMC of Coquillam requesting a reply to the letter already sent to him. It was moved by Counc McDermott sec by Counc Stride & resolved that no more work be employed on the Cumberland Rd from the Box of the hill to Burnaby Cove. The clerk was instructed to write to the Directors of the Royal Columbian Hospital and inquire what yearly subscription was needed to entitle this Corporation to the use of a bed with attendants etc in the Hospital also to write to Coquitlam Langley Sunney Municipal Councils or to their joining with this Council in the subscription.

The clerk was instructed to employ alter Hill CE & P & S. to take the levels needed to show the water in the ditches on the new Wiggins road can be carried off. That Councillor Robertson be requested to accompany Mr Hill and chat tenders

to be in not later than 2 pm 2^d May to do the required work be called for by Advertisement in the Daily Columbian Council Sprott was authorized to employ the labor necessary for the clearing of obstructions on the Johnston road

The Clerk was instructed to write to the Provincial road super of this District directing his attention to the bad state of Hastings road through the Hastings Townsite informing him that this road is used by many of the settlers and the Hamilton Power Co use it for the conveyance of explosives & respectfully requesting him to have the needed repairs done

Ernest Easthope's amended account of work on the Grossepont contract was brought before the Council - this acct showed that \$47. was still due to him and it was resolved that he be paid that amount

Councillors Robertson & Stride were authorized to attend to ridding 2 Avenue of the water thrown

Mr. Hugh Stewart was authorized to put 2 days labor on the Hastings road for some repairs needed

Mr. Eli Lueders having resigned his contract to make sec y of Boundary road an unfortunate accident having compelled this action it was resolved that the next tenders be given the contract on failing him that Lueders be called for
