

The Council met in the Clearing Office
 on Saturday the 18th at 9pm 1896
 Present: Councilors Smith, Spratt & Wade
 McDermott & Robertson
 The Riser not being present it was resolved
 that Council Robertson take the chair
 The minutes of last meeting (at min) were
 read and a dispute occurred
 between Robertson reported that he had
 examined the work done on his work orders
 and found out and outligned the clerk, he had
 from Wednesday the 14th - 15th and it was moved
 by Council Spratt that Council Smith and
 Robertson take Council Robertson's action to
 appear
 Commencement (was) from New
 York and the Code was read over in the
 morning on the Kansas property history
 of the State. William and the other in the
 matter of Robert's daughter have been
 called for and it was resolved that
 their communications be read and
 it was moved by Council McDermott
 that Council Smith withdraw that this
 Council accept the offer of \$13000
 to sell Section 23 of lot 95 - further proceeds
 were taken under the name and
 the Chair Vice Robertson resigned
 The Riser read a letter he had received
 from Mr. Aldermatt 20th July 1896
 for 12c. in the matter of the Great West
 of Roads for Lays in which there was
 also a statement Numbered 1075 and it
 was resolved that the letter be received for

It was moved by Council Spott secondly Council Smith & resolved that the clerk be instructed to write to Messrs Corboux & McColl informing them that this Council purposes taking no action in the matter of the Lander Mortgage

It was moved by Council Stride secondly Council Spott & resolved that Mr Lander be allowed \$10- per month while he is unable to work

It was also resolved that Councillors Smith & Spott be a committee to interview Mrs Cherry and make arrangements for her to board lodge and care for Mr Lander while he is unable to care for himself and that the Committee be given a cheque for \$10- the cash to be used for this purpose

It was resolved that Patterson & Withrow be paid at next meeting of the Council the balance \$10- due them on their contract for clearing on Vancouver road & Boundary Rd Messrs Booth & Shrusell were awarded a contract to do the regrading work called for on 374 Avenue for \$50- the work to be done within 30 days

The Council then adjourned to meet again in the same place at 2 p.m. of Saturday 1st August next
