

20 June 1896

The Council met in room No 1 Mosson bldg  
New Westminster City on Saturday 20 June  
1896 at 2 p.m.

There were present Councillors Robertson  
Stride McDermott Smith & Sprouth

The minutes of last meeting (Correct)  
were read and adopted

The Reeve not being present it was resolved  
that Counc McDermott take the chair  
Counc Robertson reported that he had let  
a contract to Messrs Patterson & Withrow to  
clear about 1500 sq yds of land within  
the road limits of Central Park road for  
\$ 350 and on motion the report was adopted

Reeve Schow entered the room and took  
the chair vice McDermott resigned  
Counc Stride reported as to having had the  
repairs needed on the Vancouver road done  
and the report was adopted

Counc Smith reported in the matter  
of reducing the grade and improving the  
roadway on 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Aven<sup>s</sup> and it was resolved  
that tenders be invited for doing this work  
by advertising in next issue of weekly  
Columbian Tenders to be in not later than  
2 p.m. 4<sup>th</sup> July Counc McDermott to furnish  
specifications of the work to be done

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Specifications to be on view at the  
Clerk's Office after next Thursday

The Clerk was instructed to do what  
is necessary to complete the purchase  
of Mr W. H. Harris's bbl 27 of lot 95 at  
\$85 per acre

This meeting being the last  
that would be held this month and  
quarter — It was resolved that

the Indemnities due to the Reeve  
& Councillors and the Salary of the  
Clerk up to the end of this month  
be paid i.e. Coun Robertson \$18  
Coun Stride \$21 Coun McDermott \$21  
Coun Smith \$21 Coun Spott \$15

Reeve Schon \$21 & Admstr. McC \$24  
Councillors Robertson Smith & Stride  
were appointed a committee to inspect  
the work New Woodlark had done on his  
contract to do what work is necessary  
to take the water off the new Whiff's Rd  
The Council then adjourned  
till Saturday the 4 July at 2 pm
