The Reeve Reported for the Delegation
 to Victoria to oppose the passing of the
 Consolidated Railway & Electric Light Co Bill
 in its present shape that an Amendment
 had been to the Bill had been agreed upon
 which would leave the Council of Streets
 Bridges Highways in the Power of Municipalities
 Requests were read for Corduroy on Hatch
 road and Central Park road also for extension
 of Byrne road no action was taken and
 the further consideration was deferred till
 next meeting

Applications for the positions of
 Constables were opened and read but there
 being some doubt of the power of the Council
 to enforce the Wide Side Act without having
 first passed a Bylaw for that purpose it
 was resolved that no further action be taken
 until an opinion was obtained in this
 matter

The Temporary Loan Bylaw was introduced
 and read a first time by title

Plans of the North
 road from A. Hill P. S. were presented
 and it was resolved that Coquellan Council

be invited to attend the next meeting of this Council at 4 pm to hold a consultation in this matter

The Clerk was instructed to write to the Tramway Co requesting them to comply with their Agreement as to laying planks alongside the rails and properly ballasting same

A Deputation attended from Central Park for the purpose of requesting this Council to recommend

Mr D Withrow to the proper P.O. authorities as a suitable person for Postmaster of the Central Park P.O. it was resolved that the Clerk be instructed to forward the requested recommendation

It was reported to the Council that Messrs Liley Bros had flooded part of the Byrne road injured and washed away part of the Corduroy thereon besides otherwise damaging the road and it was resolved that the Clerk be instructed to inform Messrs Liley Bros that if they do not at once repair and make good any damage caused by any act of theirs that any privileges acquired under a certain Agreement will be rescinded

The Council then Adjourned to meet again in the same place at 3 o'clock in the Afternoon of Saturday, the 29 inst
