

2<sup>nd</sup> May 1896

The Council met at 2 o'clock  
in the afternoon of 23 May 1896  
All the members of Council  
were present.

The minutes of last meeting  
11 May were <sup>read</sup> adopted

Mrs H S Tallot representing the  
Investment department of the  
Sun Life Assurance Co of Canada  
interviewed the Council in the matter  
of the Council having such work done  
as would give an outlet for water taken  
off top part of lot 92 Group 1 formerly  
owned by Mrre Breuchley and it was  
moved by Councillor Smith secy to Councillor  
McDermott & resolved that Councillor  
Robertson be authorized to hire labor to  
clean out the ditch on the road near  
this place

The tenders for making fence of on  
the North road were opened and it  
was resolved that Messrs H Plessis &  
A Wilsons tender be accepted they  
agreeing to cover any corduroying or bridging  
with cedar bark for \$5= extra.

Councillor Smith reported in the matter  
of the sick man placed in the Royal  
Columbian Hospital and it was  
moved by Councillor Sprott secy to Councillor  
McDermott & resolved that Councillor Smith  
be appointed as a committee in this  
matter to take what action he might  
think best with four to act  
Councillor Slade reported as to some

needed work on the Vancouver road  
that had been done

It was resolved that Councillor Slade and  
Robertson be authorized to purchase from  
Mr G H Harris a gravel lot either block 24  
or 28 being preferred

The Treas reported that about 21  
chains of corduroy was needed on the  
unpaved road also some gravel

It was resolved that Seiders be  
invited for about 21 chains of corduroy  
on the Hastings road between Stile Creek  
and the boundary the corduroy to be 10 ft  
long and not less than 4 inches thick  
in the thinnest part and bedded or covered  
4 inches - The advertisement to be inserted  
once each in the World & Columbian  
daily news

It was resolved that the Clerk's  
monthly salary \$27 - The Collector \$16.  
40 for mps & Post stamp and \$150-00 on  
debentures due 1<sup>st</sup> June be paid  
also that \$150- be borrowed under the  
Temporary Loan By law

The Clerk was instructed to write to the  
C P & R C requesting them to place  
fleaks on their track when it crosses the  
boundary road

It was moved by Councillor Robertson seconded  
by Councillor McDermott resolved that Jno Shafers  
contract be cancelled for non completion of  
same and the Contract be awarded  
to next bidders

23<sup>rd</sup> May 1896

Ralph Robinson to get sec 2 Central Park road at \$3.75 per chain & sec 2 Beefer road \$43.85 per chain and Evans Blair to get sec 3 at \$2.50 per chain

It was resolved that Councillor Robertson be authorized to let a contract not to exceed \$25 for a trail so that dwellers on Blks 28 & 29 of lot 152 may have access to their holdings.

Mr Burgess offer to build the small bridge required on sec 8 of the Boundary road for 50 per foot was accepted

The Revenue By law was read a first time. The Rules of order were suspended and it was read a second & third time and passed — The Council then adjourned till Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> June next at 2 o'clock in the afternoon
