

The Council met in the clerks office on Saturday the 24<sup>th</sup> October at 2 o'clock in the afternoon

They were present Revere Schou in the chair and Councilors Swides Mc Dermott Smith & Spott

The minutes of last meeting <sup>at</sup> were read and adopted

After some discussion as to the best way to be adopted to compel compliance with the provisions of the Wide Curb By Law. It was moved by Council Spott second by Council McDermott & resolved that the clerk be instructed to write to Mr Wm Bailey Central Park requesting him to attend the next meeting of this Council with a view to his appointment as a Special Constable to attend to the enforcing of this By Law. The following communications were read and dealt with as stated

From Mr Maxwell Smith complaining that the triangular piece of road close to Central Park had not been properly finished & the matter was received & filed

From Mr C F Caldwell applying for a loan of \$250- on mortgage of his house and lot was received & filed

From Mr John Manline in the matter of an accident that had happened to his wife and daughter through the upsetting of his rig was laid over till next meeting for consideration and action if any

Council McDermott Reported that the ditches on the North road are partly filled up

and recommending them being cleaned out and the material taken there from spread on the centre of the road and it was moved by Council Smiths acct by Council Mc Dermott & resolved that the Reeve be requested to write to the Reeve of Coquitlam requesting that Council to cooperate in having this needed work done with regard to the broken plank on the Brunette road bridge. It was resolved that Council Mc Dermott be authorized to have the same repaired. Laurence Drummer Esq. addressed the Council complaining of the damage caused to him by the water from the road ditch running onto his land and it was resolved that tenders to improve the ditch be invited by Advertisement in one issue each of the Columbian & News Advertiser. Council Stride agreeing to furnish the plans & specifications of the work. The tenders to be in by 2 pm of Saturday 7 Nov next.

It was resolved that the Clerk & Collector be paid \$34.25 as per Alfred Smithers bill that \$430. be transferred from No 2 to No 1 acct and that Cheque be drawn signed for Coupons \$300: due 1<sup>st</sup> Nov

The Bunnaby road appropriation Bylaw 1896 was read first time the Rules were suspended and it was 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> time.

The Council then Adjourned to meet again in the same place on Saturday the 7<sup>th</sup> of November next at 2 pm.
