requesting them to cause the Shittles  
growing on their land near the  
Power house to be destroyed

The Reeve and Councillor  
McDermott agreed to wait on Messrs  
Dumstres in the matter of the  
Mortgage on Mrs Keli Landers property  
It was resolved that a Public  
Meeting of the Ratepayers of Burnaby  
be held in the new Westminster  
City Hall at 4 pm next Saturday 11th inst  
and that the Clerk have a short Address  
calling such meeting in one Issue each  
of the News Advertiser & Columbian

The Council then adjourned  
to meet again in the same place on  
Saturday the 18th inst at 2 pm.
