

6 June 1896

The Council met at 2 o'clock
in the afternoon of Saturday 6 June 1896.
All the members of the Council were
present — The minutes of last
meeting 23 May were read and
adopted — Council Robertson
reported that under authority
given him at last meeting of this
Council he had employed E. Easthope
Jr to clean out ditch on Vancouver Rd.
It was resolved that Council Robertson's
report be adopted and E. Easthope Jr

be paid \$6- the amt of his bill for four days labor

Corine Robertson reported that he has let contract to Messrs Campbell Patterson and Withrow to make the trail from the Royal Oak road to some of the small holdings for \$2450 and the report was adopted

As the Contractors had thrown up their contracts for making portions of the Reefer & Central Park. It was resolved that H. Plester offer to make sections 2 & 3 of the Reefer road at \$5 & 240 respectively be accepted it being understood that \$2 the amt paid for work done on this piece of road be deducted from the amt paid him also that Mr Ralph Robinson be given the contract to make the sec on the Central Park road at \$5.75 per chain

 Council Smith reported he had made
 arrangements with the Trustees of the
 C. Hospital whereby Stephen Chase the
 paralyzed destitute man would be cared
 for by the Hospital at the expense
 of \$20- per month to Bunnaby
 Council Smith's report was adopted
 Mr H. Plester agreed to place filling instead
 of bridging on his contract on the north
 road the filling to be 20 ft across at
 the top for the sum of 10 yds
 The tenders received for doing the
 Corduroying on the Hartings road were
 opened and Mr W. H. Redgro tendered at \$3.96
 per chain was accepted
 Councillor Robertson was authorized
 to let by tender the clearing of about
 1500 sq yds of land at Central Park
 Council M. Dermott Smith & Stride were
 appointed a Committee to prepare
 specifications for improving the grade of
 5th Avenue Council Stride was
 authorized to hire a man and team for
 about 2 days repairing some ruts & hollows
 on the Vancouver road
 The Revenue Bylaw and Statute Labor
 Bylaw were reconsidered finally passed

to be signed sealed and delivered.
