

6 June 1896

The Council met at 2 o'clock  
in the afternoon of Saturday 6 June 1896  
All the members of the Council were  
present — The minutes of last  
meeting 23 May were read and  
adopted — Cowen Robertson  
reported that under authority  
given him at last meeting of this  
Council he had employed Easthope  
Jr to clean out ditch on Vancouver Rd  
It was resolved that Cowen Robertson's  
report be adopted and Easthope Jr

be paid \$6 - the sum of his bill for four days labor

Corine Robertson reported that he had let contracts to Messrs Campbell Patterson and Wilkison to make the trail from the Royal Oak road to some of the small holdings for \$2450 and the report was adopted.

As the Contractors had thrown up their contracts for making portions of the New Central Park. It was resolved that H. Plesler offer to make sections 2 & 3 of the Hupper road at \$5 & 290 respectively be accepted it being understood that  $\frac{1}{2}$  the amount paid for work done on this piece of road be deducted from the amount paid him also that Mr Ralph Robinson be given the contract to make the sec on the Central Park road at \$3.75 per chain.

Coupe Smith reported he had made  
 arrangements with the Trustees of the  
 C Hospital whereby Stephen chase the  
 paralyzed destitute man would be cared  
 for by the Hospital at the expense  
 of \$20 per month to Burnaby

Coupe Smith's report was adopted  
 Mr H Plester agreed to place filling instead  
 of bridging on his contract on the hall  
 road the filling to be 20 ft across at  
 the top for the sum of 10 yards  
 The tenders received for doing the  
 corduroying on the Hastings road were  
 opened and Mr W H Redgrove's bid at \$3.96  
 per chain was accepted

Councillor Robertson was authorized  
 to let by tender the clearing of about  
 1500 sq yds of land at Central Park  
 Coupe McDermott Smith & Stride were  
 appointed a Committee to prepare  
 specifications for improving the grade of  
 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Coupe Stride was  
 authorized to hire a man and team for  
 about 2 days repairing some rut hollows  
 on the Vancouver road

The Revenue By law and Statute labor  
 By law were reconsidered & finally passed
