It was resolved that Geo Gibbons contract to make sections 5 6 & 8 of the Boundary road be cancelled the work done by him valued and that tenders be invited for completing same by Advertisements in Weekly Columbian and Daily World — It was resolved that an advertisement be put in the Columbian inviting applications for position of Constable in the District who would be expected to enforce compliance with the Wide Tire Act

It was moved by Council Sproul second by Council Stride resolved that tenders be invited by Advertisement in the World and Columbian for the making of about 50 chains of roadway in 5 sections on the small subdivisions of lot 153 also for extending The Grosvenor road about 10 chains

It was resolved that Geo Easthope offer to lay Gordanroy at \$3- per chain be accepted and also to do ditching for \$1.50 per chain be accepted

This would be extras on Geo Easthopes contract  
It was resolved that H A Eastman be appointed Assessor the terms to be arranged at next meeting when Mr Eastman is requested to be present — Council Sproul was authorized to let a contract for extending the Logan road about 6 chains Council Stride was authorized to hire a team and two men to spread broken stone on the Vancouver road — a ballot was taken for the election of a medical health Officer and R E Walker M D was elected \$450 to be the Annual

and Reeve Schou was appointed as a

The Council then Adjourned  
to meet again in same place on  
Saturday the 22 Feb. at 2 p.m.
