Council Stride reported in the matter of the
alleged ~~unlawful~~ damage trees on the Hotel road
that he had measured the road and
found the trees to be outside the road
limits - Comm Smith reported in the
matter of John Woollard's ditch contract

that the snow and rain had interfered with the completion of this contract.

It was resolved that Geo. Gibson's contract to make sections 5, 6 & 8 of the Boundary road be cancelled. The work done by him valued and that tenders be invited for completing same by advertisements in Weekly Columbian and Daily World. It was resolved that an advertisement be put in the Columbian inviting applications for position of Constable in the District who would be expected to enforce compliance with the Wide Street Act.

It was moved by Councillor Spott and by Councillor Stride resolved that tenders be invited by advertisement in the World and Columbian for the making of about 50 chains of roadway in 5 sections on the small subdivisions of lots 103 also for extending the Grosvenor road about 10 chains.

It was resolved that G Easthope Jr offer to lay Gorduroy at \$3 per chain be accepted and also to do ditching for \$1.50 per chain be accepted.

This would be extras on Easthope's contract. It was resolved that H A Eastman be appointed Assessor the terms to be arranged at next meeting when Mr Eastman is requested to be present — Councillor Spott was authorized to let a contract for extending the Legion road about 6 chains. Councillor Stride was authorized to hire a team and two men to spread broken stone on the Vancouver road — a ballot was taken for the election of a medical health officer and R W Walker M.D. was elected to be the annual

of New Westminster city requesting
the Burnaby Council to have the
Petitions for the Bridge across the
Fraser signed and sealed was laid
before the Council and the Reeve and
Clerk were instructed to sign & affix
the corporate Seal to the Petition and
then forward it to Hrs Mrid McP.P.
and Reeve Schow was appointed as a
Delegate to represent this Council.

The Council then Adjourned
to meet again in same place on
Saturday the 22 Feb. at 2 p.m.
