It was moved by Comr Cliff Secty
Comr Spott resolved that Wm
Bailey be employed as Constable
for another month to act as sanitary
Inspector protect the roads from being
damaged besides his ordinary duties
and anything else the Council may
require him to do

Comr Stride was authorized to have
50 notices regarding the preservation of
the roads and notices printed on cloth
The Bay Sale Bylaw was introduced
but no action was taken thereon it
being resolved that a special meeting of
the Council be held next Saturday
20th inst at 2 pm. to deal with this notice
It was resolved that the Board of works
meet in New Westminster on Thursday next
18th inst at 8.30 am. for the purpose of
reviewing the roads to see what is needed
