 Councillor elect ^{having} having made the necessary declaration took his seat and full Council was present

Mrs Wm Bailey sccty School Trustees Central Park School informed the Council that part of the road limit between the School house and the road had not yet been cleared and Councillor Cridland was authorized to have this done the cost not to exceed £5.

Councillors Spott & Stride were appointed a committee to interview the Medical Health Officer as to his visiting the Slaughter houses and other matters. It was moved by Councillor Cliff sccty Councillor Spott resolved that Wm Bailey be employed as Constable for another month to act as sanitary Inspector protect the roads from being damaged besides his ordinary duties and anything else the Council may require him to do

Councillor Stride was authorized to have 50 notices regarding the preservation of the roads and ditches printed on cloth. The Say Sale By Law was introduced but no action was taken thereon it being resolved that a special meeting of the Council be held next Saturday 20 inst at 2 p.m. to deal with this matter. It was resolved that the Board of works meet in New Westminster on Thursday next 18 inst at 8.30 A.M. for the purpose of reviewing the roads to see what is needed

and the Clerk was instructed to hire the necessary vehicle for the conveyance of the Board.

A communication from Mr J Shrift applying for the position of Collector was read and this position having been filled the communication was received and filed.

A communication from Mr R McBride Secty Farmers cheap money convention was read. This was a request that Burnaby Council would appoint a delegate to act with their delegation in interviewing the Govt to further the object of their convention and on motion the communication was received and filed.
