Councilor Stride Reported that he had let a contract to E. Easthope Jr for the Corduroy on Vancouver road at \$6.33 per chain

Councilor Cridland Reported having let a contract to Ralph Robinson to do some needed work on the Vancouver road for \$100

It was resolved that George Love be awarded the contract for box drain on 4th Avenue at 12 cents per foot

A Petition from Wm. Barley & Grimmer et al. was read This was a request to have road opened up from W 9th V. road to the North arm road so that children dwelling in the North arm District may be able to attend the West Burnaby School and it was agreed that The Reeve & Councilors Cluff & Stride should in company with A. D. W. H. G. and visit the line of the proposed road next Saturday report at next meeting of the Council

Councilor Stride agreed to obtain tenders for hauling gravel from the City limit
It was Resolved that tenders be invited by advertising in Weekly Columbian semi weekly work, once in each issue for about 20 chains of corduroy on Hastings road and making & grading roadway on 5th Avenue Specifications to be seen at Clerk Office and Specifications of Corduroy at Councilor Stride's Residence also tenders to be in on or before 2 p.m. Saturday 27th March
