The Council met in the Clerk's Office Armstrong block on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> May 1894 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon

There were present Reeve Schou and Councillors Cudland Ledger Spott & Stride

Mr J D Heeson interviewed the Council in the matter of his promised contribution towards the cost of making the Boundary road. He claimed that the area of his land liable for taxation and bordering on the Boundary road is less than stated in the Assessment notice and after some discussion it was Resolved to accept \$250 as payment in full of the promised subscription.

The Reeve read a letter from Mr C Estopa Agent for the Pickles property - this was in the matter of Subscription to cost of

of Boundary road also as to over-  
payments made for taxes arising  
from the Area of the property having  
been estimated in excess of real area  
and the matter was referred to the  
Collector for settlement he to see if the  
Amount as stated by Mr Pickles is correct  
The Revenue Bylaw was reconsidered  
and finally passed and it was  
ordered to be signed sealed & advertised  
as required by Law

A communication was received from  
the R A & S Society soliciting the  
customary donation to the Premiums  
offered at the next show - and it was  
Resolved that \$25<sup>00</sup> be again contributed  
on the same terms as before unless  
any change is made

Councillor Cridland Reported the  
having had macadam & gravel laid  
on some of the bad places on the Vanit  
Rd - and he was authorized to have a  
few more yards left where needed

It was Resolved that the Reese  
Finance committee and clerk be  
authorized & requested to Sign & Seal  
a note for \$1450<sup>00</sup> that amt being the  
bal<sup>ce</sup> as authorized by the Temporary  
Loan Bylaw i.e. \$2000<sup>00</sup>

The Council then Adjourned to  
meet again on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> inst  
at 2 o'clock in the afternoon
